Instructions: Print out a copy of each sheet for each of your parents to do by themselves. Ask them not to confer with each other on their answers. You should complete one also. Then get together with them for a short conversation to see which items you agree on and which you disagree on.

The idea is not that they will give you exactly what you want, but the idea is that you can agree on what items your allowance/spending money will cover, and then make sure those items are reasonably funded. Your parents will have some great ideas about saving money too!

Be sure to include some accountability too. Parents will be more willing to help financially if they know that the money is not going into a black hole.

If you find that you are stuck, consider offering a compromise. Agree with whatever amount they are offering but ask if you can revisit it after two months at college. You'll have some real world experience and examples for them to consider when you do.
